




Domain and Item Definitions

- Revisions and additions to the middle and high school versions
- Better balance between Protective and Risk factors
- Focus of the items on the student's context:

Level	Sample Item
Individual	It was easy to calm myself down
Family	People in my family have had lots of worries
Community	My teachers took a personal interest in me
Relationships	My friends brought out the best in me





Score Report Enhancements-Vignettes

- Users voiced a need for supports to translate WARNS scores into action
- Conversation about how WARNS results present in a student's life may be difficult
- Vignettes can facilitate conversations in youth counseling
- By externalizing personal problems from the self, vignettes can be viewed and discussed in the context of understanding and helping a hypothetical peer
- Sample excerpt (Family Environment): Milan was certain that their parents stopped caring for them a while ago. Ever since their parents' work hours extended, Milan was alone but also...not. At least for a good five hours every night, Milan's parents were right next door to them. Except by then, Milan was already asleep. And by the time Milan got up for school, their parents were already gone.
