State Advisory Board



State Team

A high-level decision-making group leveraging their expertise to inform, direct, and support ECC initiatives.

Drives policy, advocacy, and funding to support & sustain the program. Provides strategic guidance and support to local and statewide ECC efforts.

Comprised of:

- Statewide Coordinators
- QI/Data Manager
- CCYJ & AOC

Local Active Community Teams

Comprised of ECC court team members and community stakeholders, collaborates on efforts to improve access to services and supports for families with young children

- Set local goals
- Provide support and resource connection and guidance to ECCs
- Review local data to ensure equity and fidelity to SB approach



ECC/SB Courts

Comprised of dedicated court teams (as possible), including (but not limited to):

- Community Coordinator
- Judicial Leadership
- DCYF Social Worker
- Parent Attorney
- AAG
- Parent Ally (as possible)
- CASA/Child Advocate

Sites also operate a **Site Leadership Team,** comprised primarily of ECC/SBC court staff, providing day-to-day decision making of ECC operations

ZTT provides training, technical assistance, and support on all aspects of implementation and operations
